



2020 Harvest Widow Chardonnay

Region Adelaide Hills

Colour Pale straw green in colour

Aroma Purity of fruit, exhibiting grapefruit, green pear, baked apple, and flint.

Palate Mouth filling creamy texture and linear mouth-watering acidity. Well defined tasting.

Viticulture

Variety: Chardonnay
Clone: Bernard 76
Row Width: 2.5 metres
Vine Spacing: 1.8 metres
Vine Density: 2,222 vine per ha
Elevation: 390 metres above sea level
Vine Age: 24 years
Soil Type: Limestone, shale and quartz incorporated within an alluvial loam to medium clay.
Irrigation: Monitored daily drip irrigation
Shoot Thinning: by hand
Fruit Thinning: by hand
Fertiliser Program: organic matter
Bird Control: 100% of the vineyard is bird netted.
Harvesting: 100% of the vineyard is handpicked to maximise fruit quality.

Winemaking

- / 24 hrs in Coolroom / Freezer before processing
- / Whole bunch pressed
- / 25% new French oak. Damy and Chassin oak.
- / 75% 2-3 yr old French oak
- / Free run straight into barrel
- / Pressing settled 24hrs then racked
- / Wild ferment to free run
- / Ferment allowed to get to 20 degrees
- / 50% Oak portion went through malo
- / Unsulphured for 9 months and lees stirred every 3 weeks
- / Out of barrel after 9 mths, settled, racked, stabilised and bottled.
